Right out of the bottle this is a smooth, tightly constructed Pinot, layered with beetroot, tomato, sassafras and leaf scents, tasting spicy and firm. The fruit is dark and laced with coffee, and it seems certain to improve further with 3-5 years of bottle age. — P.G. (12/31/2001)
